

We want share with our customers and employees a number of operational steps to provide a clean and safe environment for our customers and employees that is compliant with Executive Order 2020-04:

1. Alleviating Clubhouse Traffic (Park & Play):

- a. Members can check-in directly with the Starter at the 1st Tee
- b. Public players can pay green/fees and carts online after booking tee-time; then check in directly with the starter
- c. League players with credit cards check-in with Starter, credit card will be charged automatically on league nights
- d. Keys will be in carts for those pre-paying
- e. Food can be ordered for take-out at the turn

2. Social Distancing on the Course:

- a. Tee-Times in ten minute intervals
- b. Maximum of four golfers to a tee time
- c. Only one player to cart; two if family members living together. Note: One player can rent a cart and carry the bag of a walking partner.
- d. Marshalls will supervise course social distancing and speed of play

3. Minimizing Surface Areas Available to Touch:

- a. Ball washers, rakes, and water stations are removed from the course
- b. Customers must bring their own range balls and clubs (no rentals)
- c. Pins can be left in the hole, hit the noodle surrounding the pin and consider the ball “holed”
- d. Credit cards will be operated by customer at self-service kiosk
- e. Credit cards can be maintained on file for approved customer purchases
- f. Restroom facilities have touchless towel dispensers

4. **Diligent Sanitization of all Key Areas:**

- a. Our Clubhouse & Restroom facilities are cleaned and sanitized daily
- b. Hand sanitizing dispensers have been added throughout the clubhouse
- c. We added intermittent daily sanitization of critical touch points in the clubhouse such as doors, door-knobs, counters and more.
- d. Golf carts are cleaned after each rental. We are sanitizing critical touch points such as seats, steering wheels, handles, etc.
- e. Employees will have protective gloves to wear.

5. ***Employee Health:***

- a. We are instructing employees who feel ill to stay home and consult their healthcare providers.
- b. We also urging all employees to be vigilant about frequent hand washing and wearing gloves.
